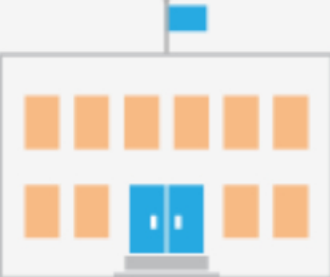

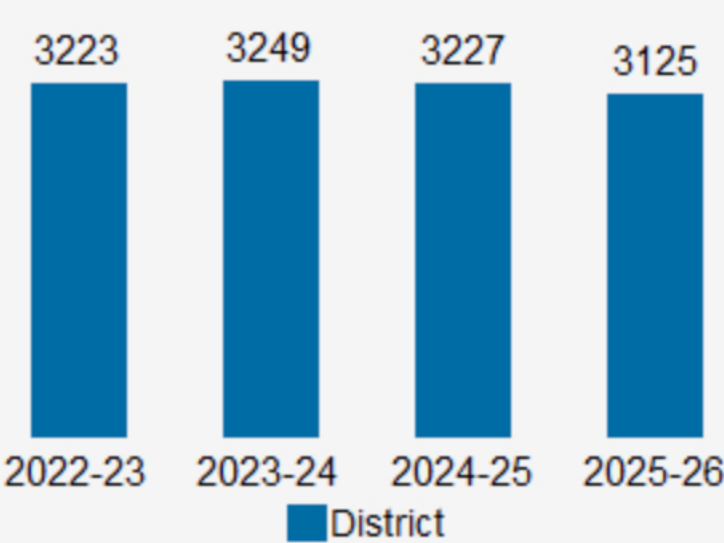

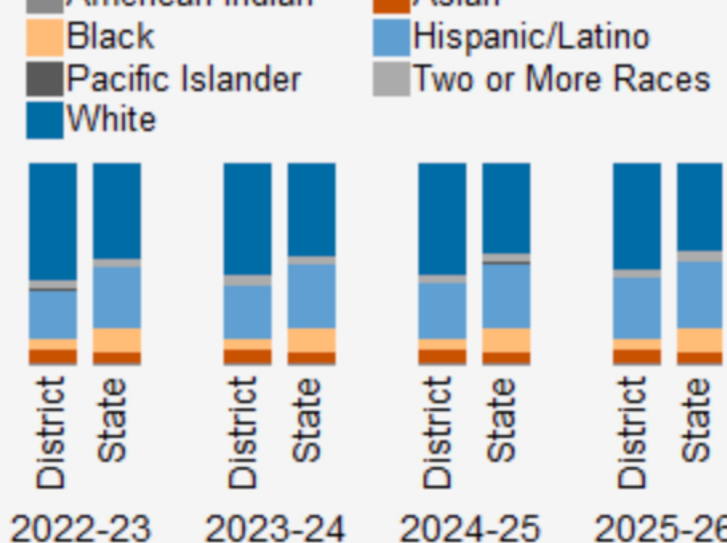

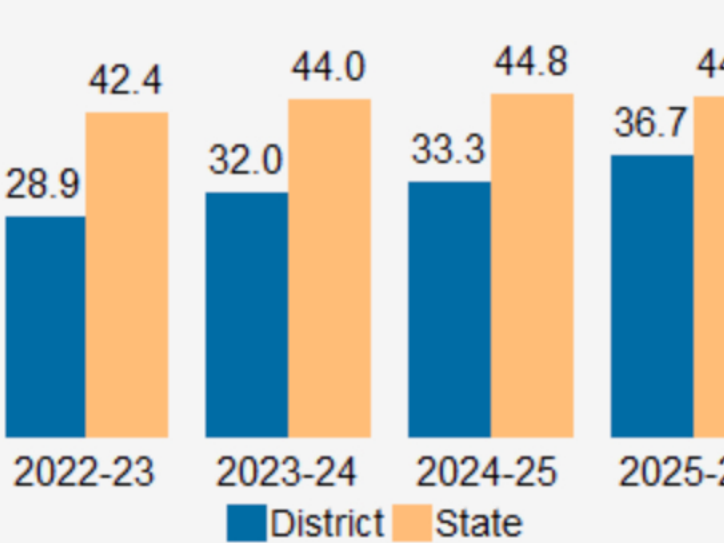

Percentage of Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity



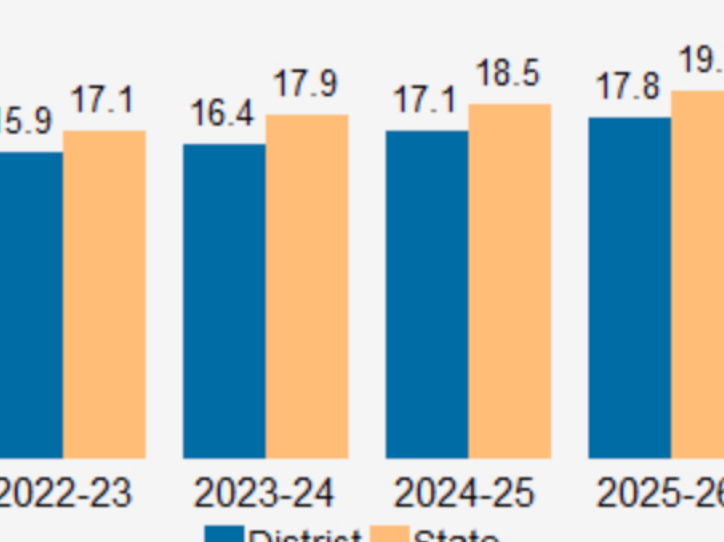

Percentage Eligible for Free/Reduced Price Meals



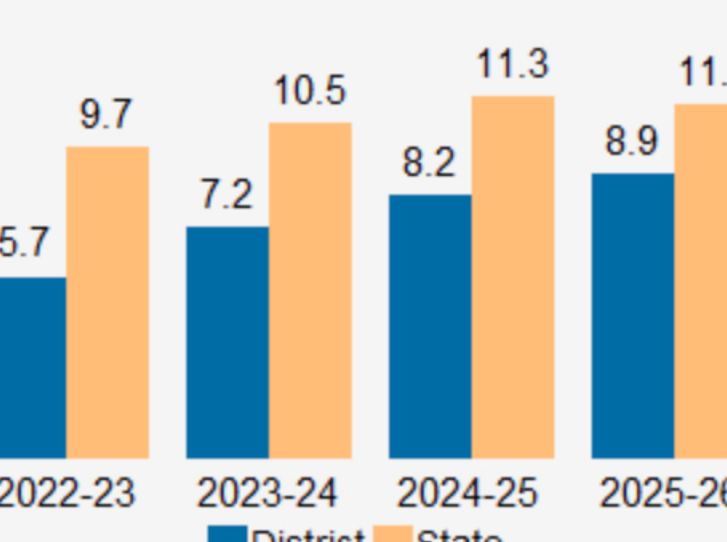

Percentage Students with Disabilities



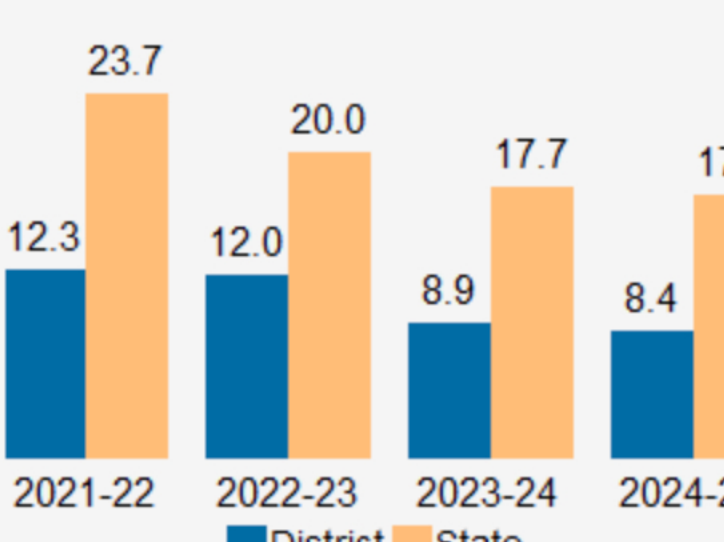

Percentage English Learners



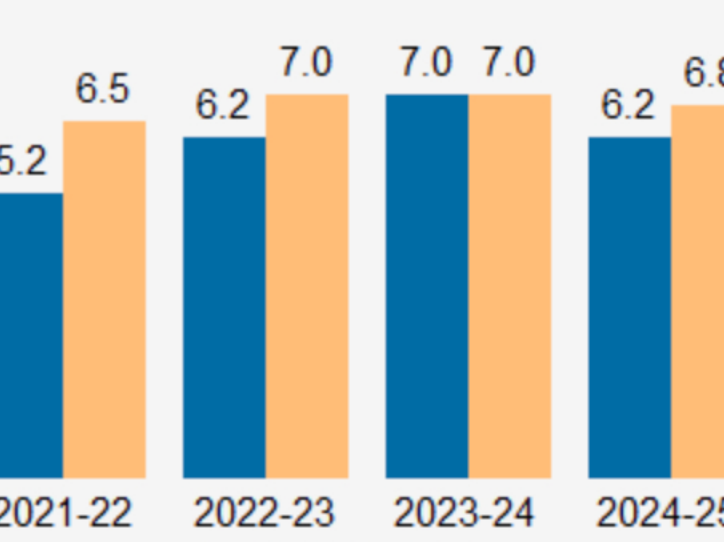

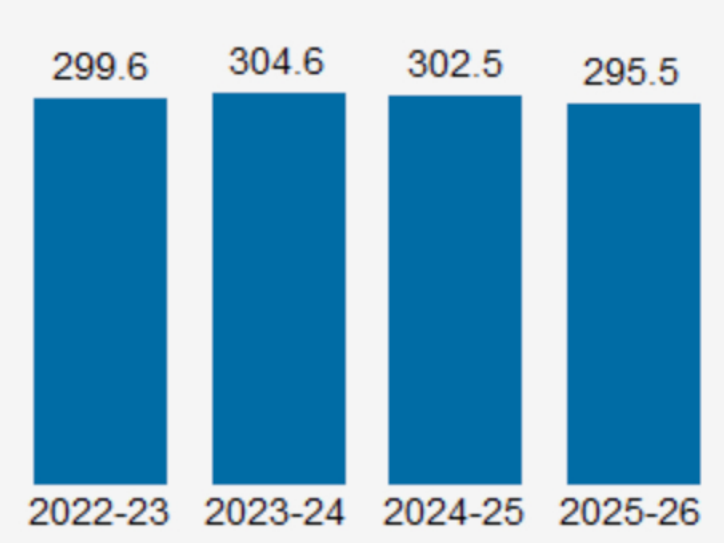

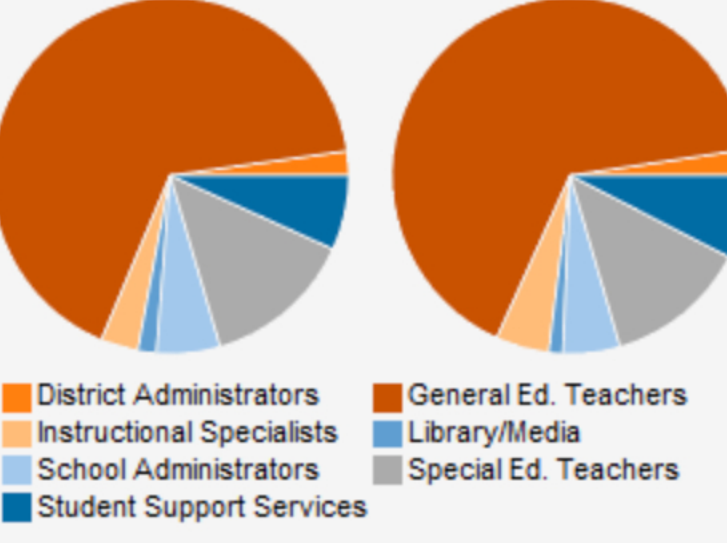

Certified Staff Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)



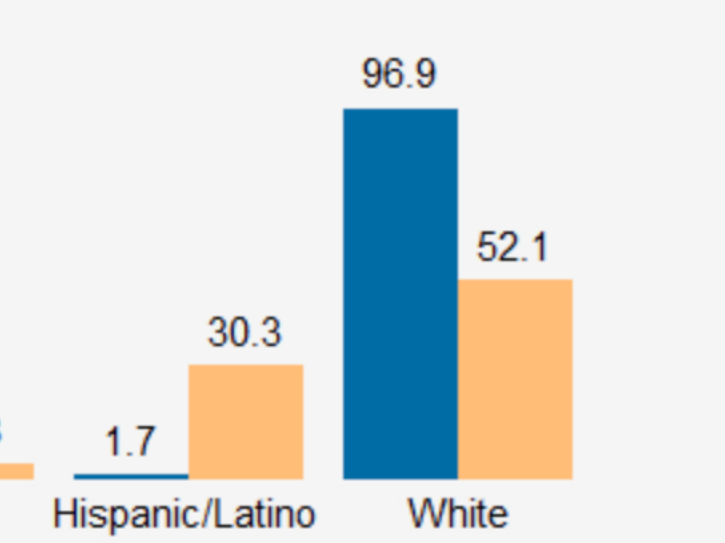

FTE by Assignment Category, 2025-26



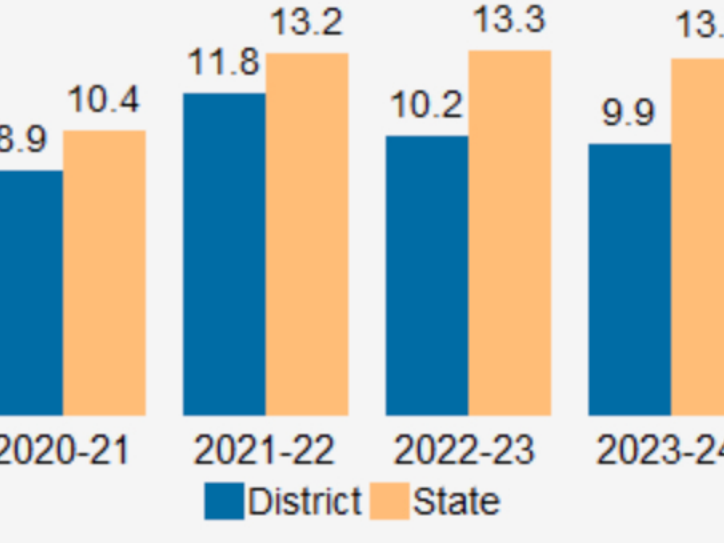

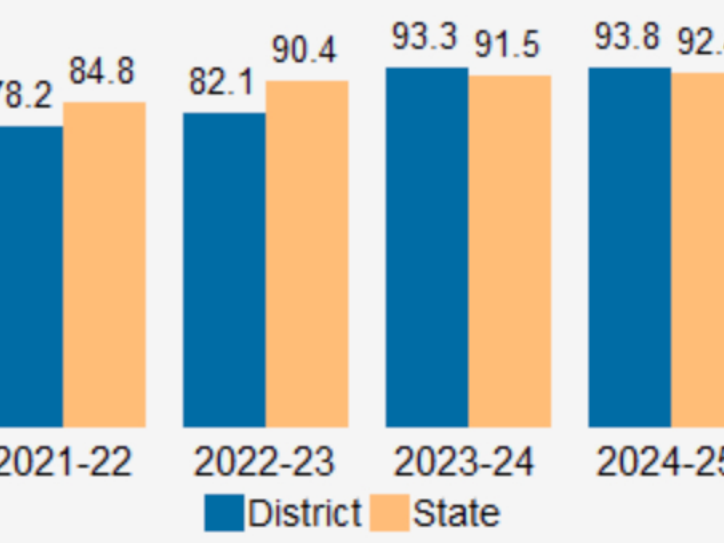
Classroom Teacher Attendance (Average FTE Days Absent)

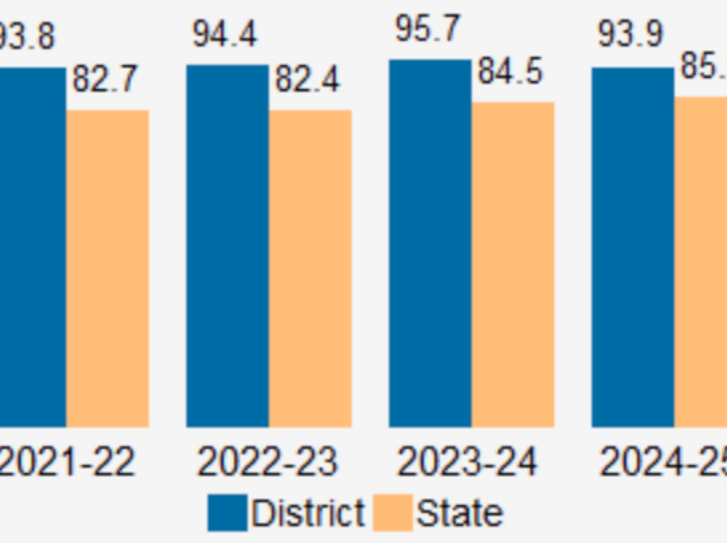

College-and-Career-Readiness Course-Taking



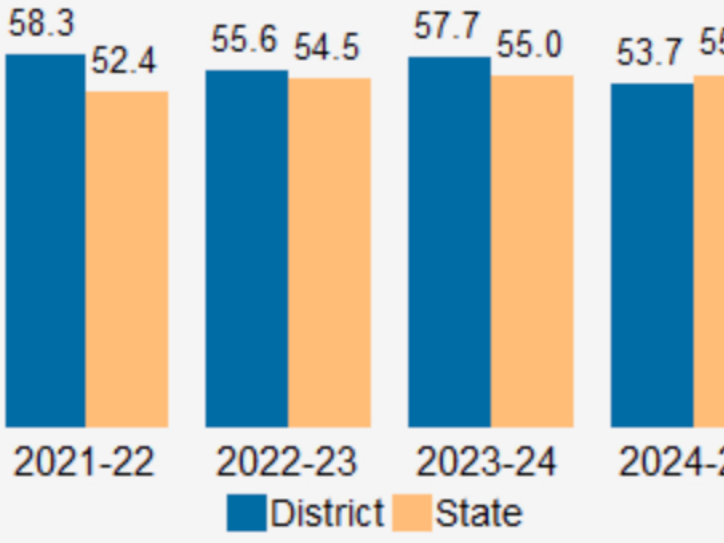

On-Track to High School Graduation



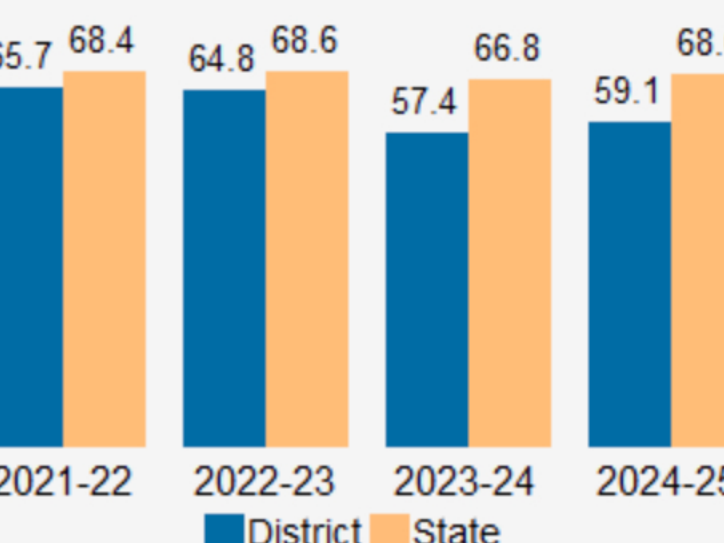

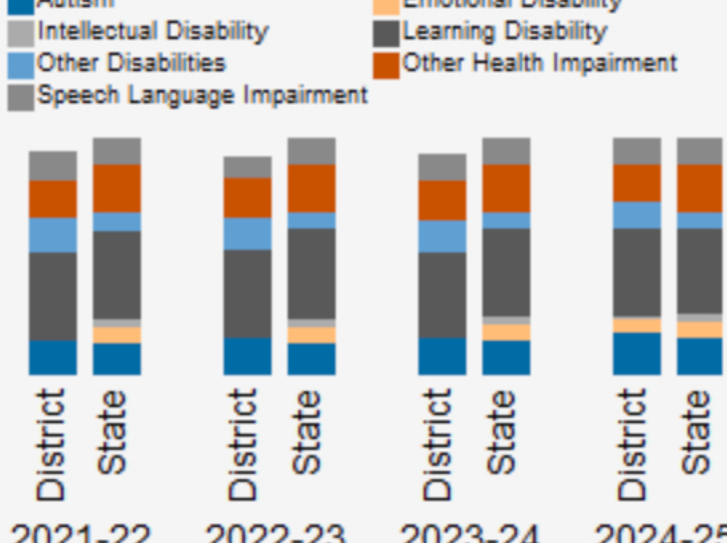

Time with Nondisabled Peers



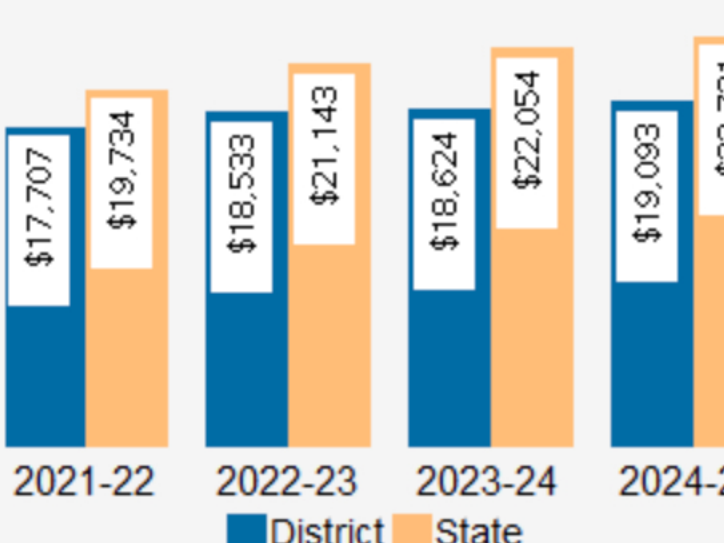

Percentage by Primary Disability



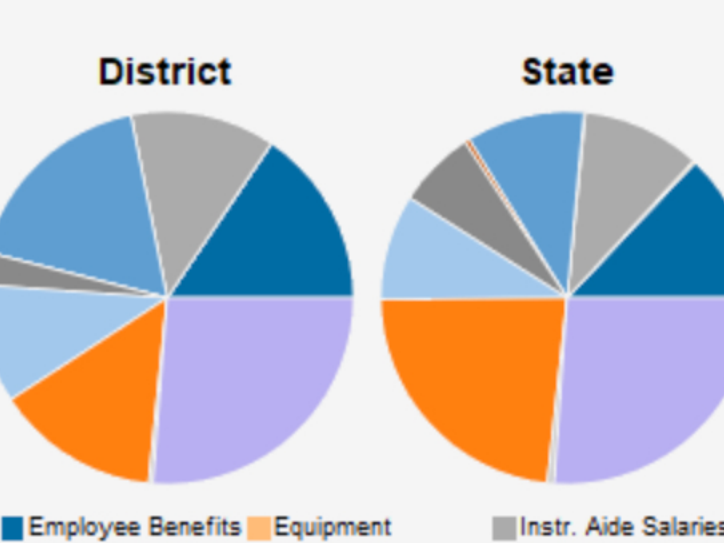

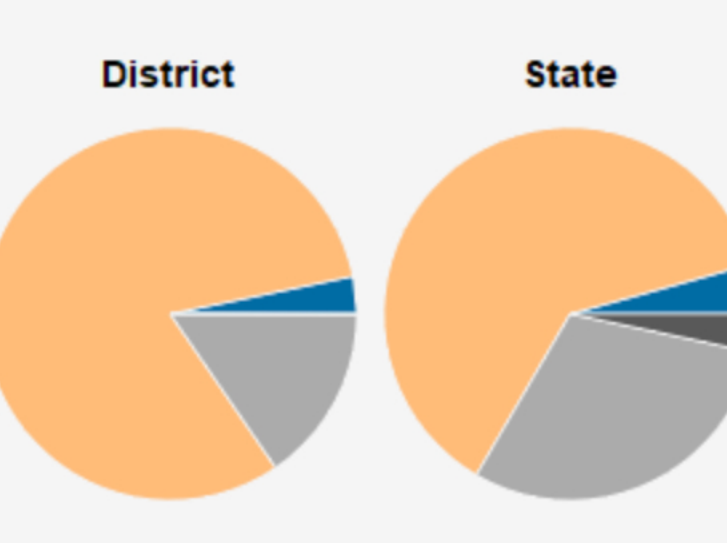

Percentage of Revenue by Source, 2024-25

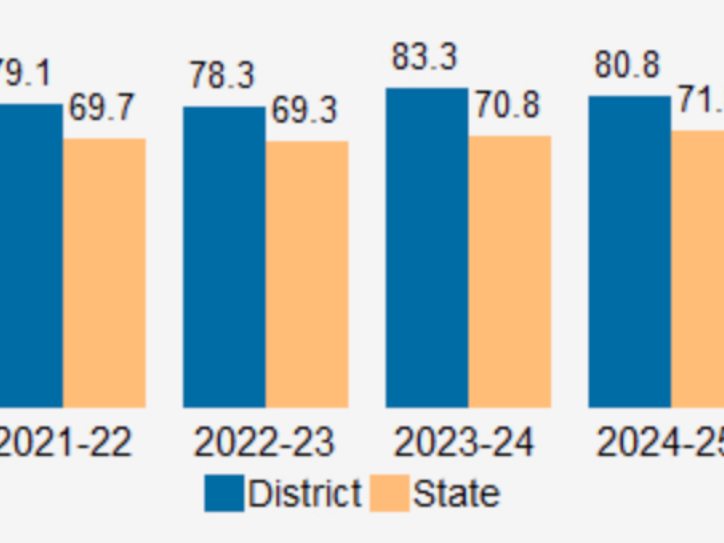

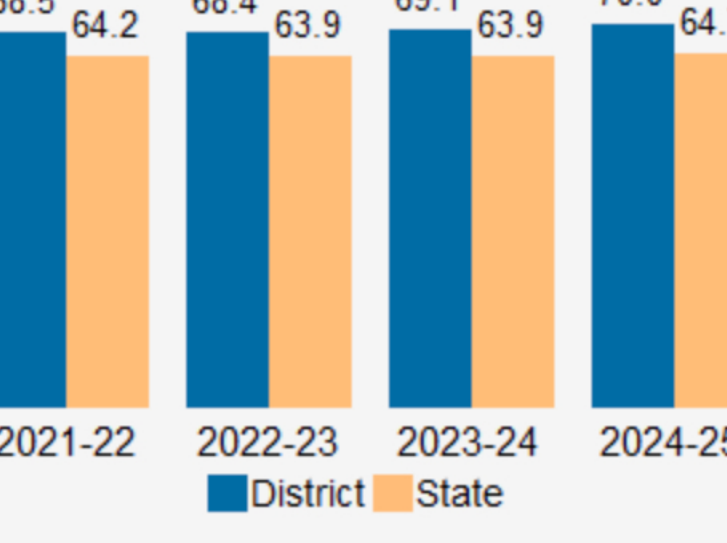

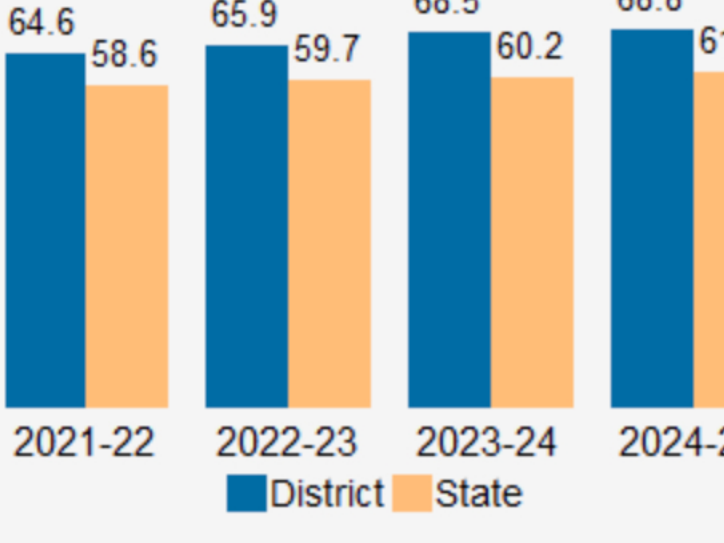

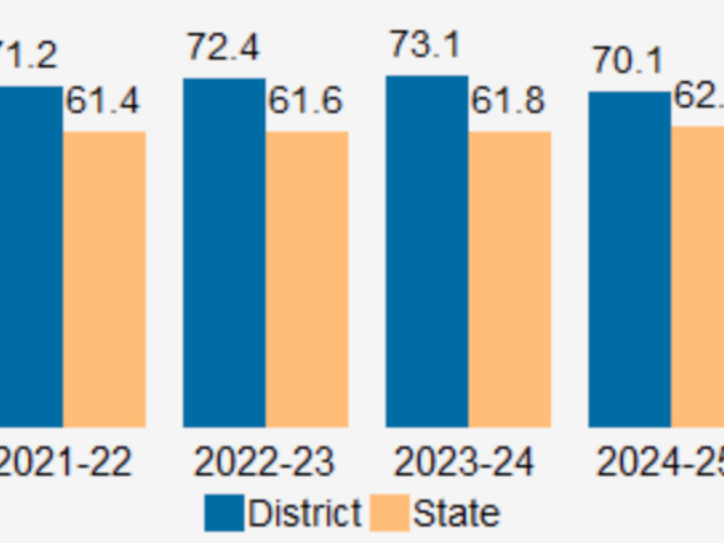

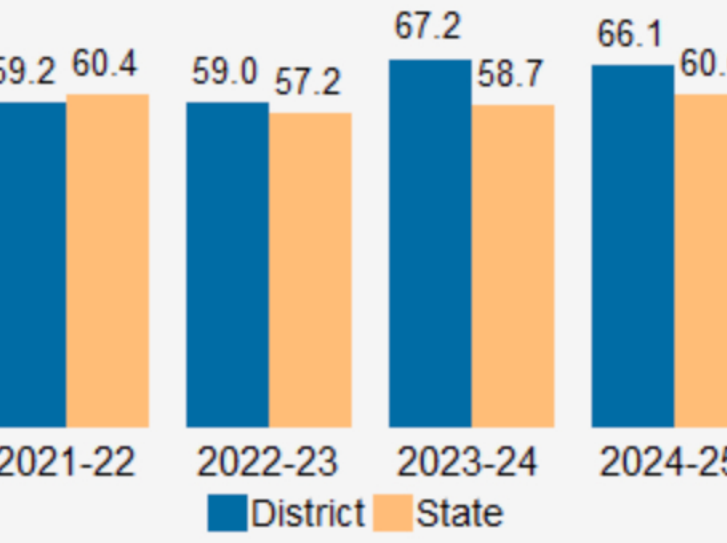

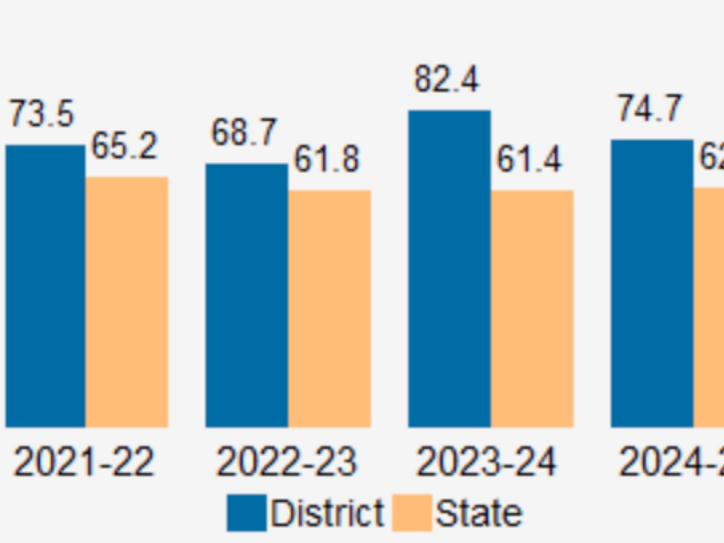

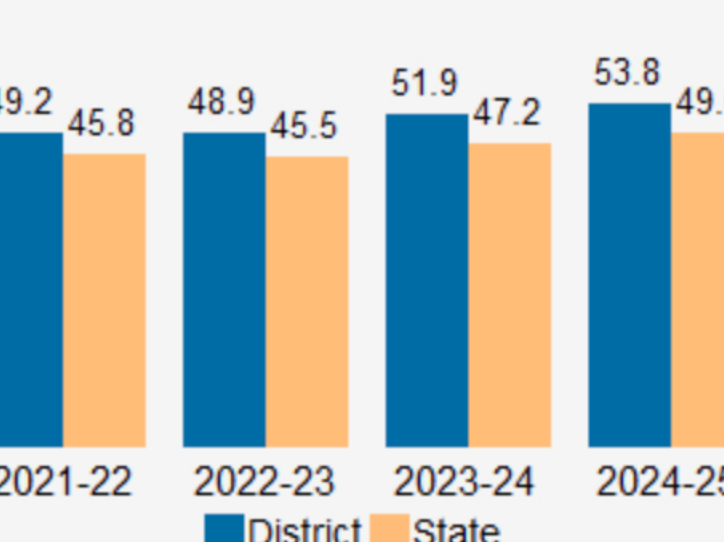

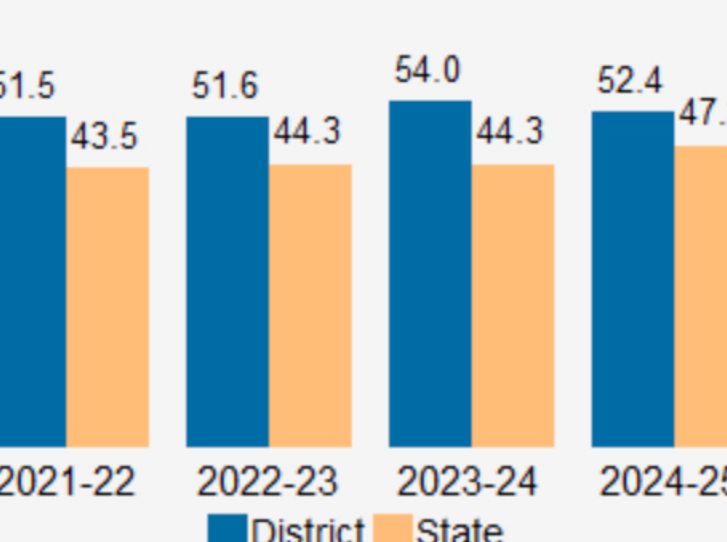

Percentage of Students Reaching Fitness Standard



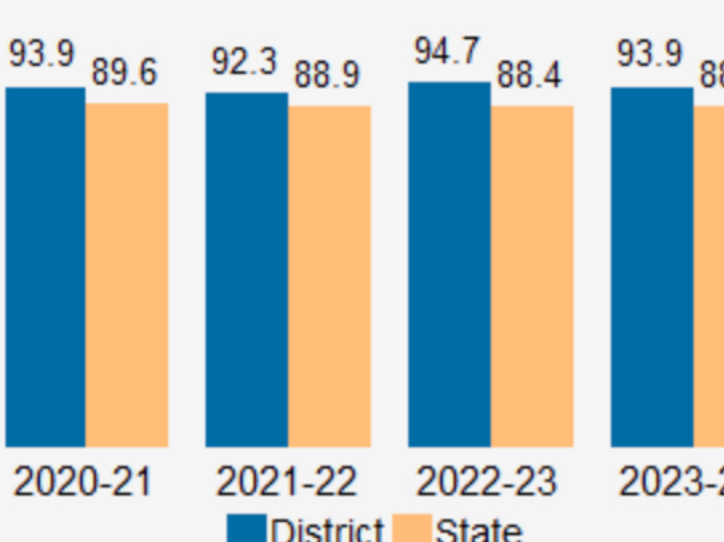

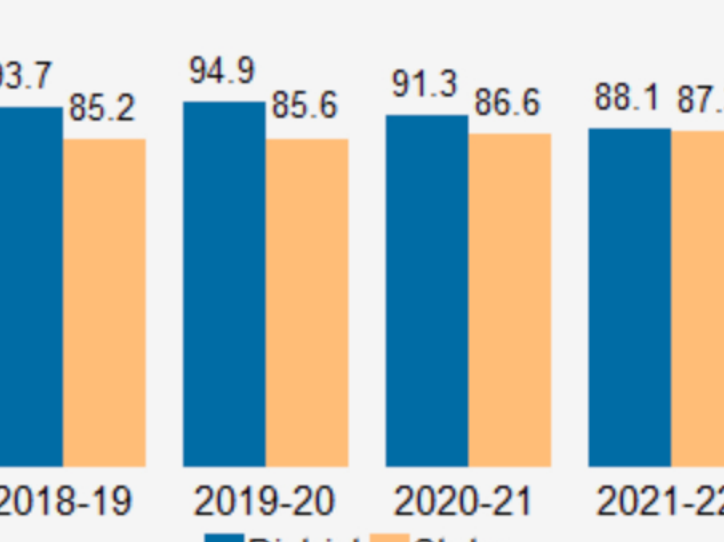

Four-Year Graduation Rate



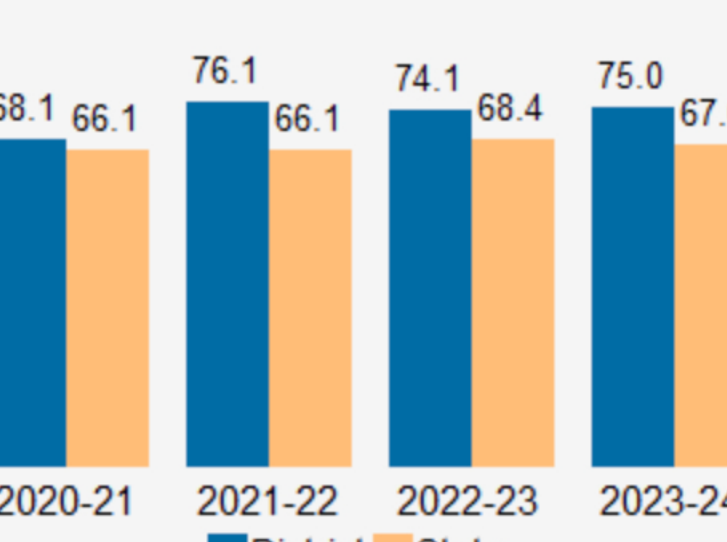
