This year we are celebrating our 19th year with the Lahaina Complex Tutor Project. The Project was honored by the Hawaii State Legislature as a **Children & Youth Day (CYD) Heroes** award winner for its extraordinary contributions to the community by supporting education.

Our biennial Aina Nalu fundraiser is a key source of funding for this ongoing program that makes a big difference in the lives of hundreds of students and their families in Lahaina public schools with all volunteer tutors. After our last fundraiser in 2017 we donated \$25,000 to the tutoring program, which sustained a good portion of the operating costs for the tutoring program for 2 years.

The owners of Aina Nalu are again planning this year's Wine and Silent Auction Fundraiser for the tutoring program, to be held in the Aina Nalu pavilion in Lahaina Town on Saturday, May 25, 2019, from 6 to 9 pm.

The grade 3 through 9 tutoring project's goal is to enhance students reading, writing, and mathematics skills for better educational success in high school and beyond. There is no guaranteed sustaining sponsor for this ongoing successful volunteer project. The annual budget has been supported through community fundraisers such as ours, some county assistance and in kind donations.
