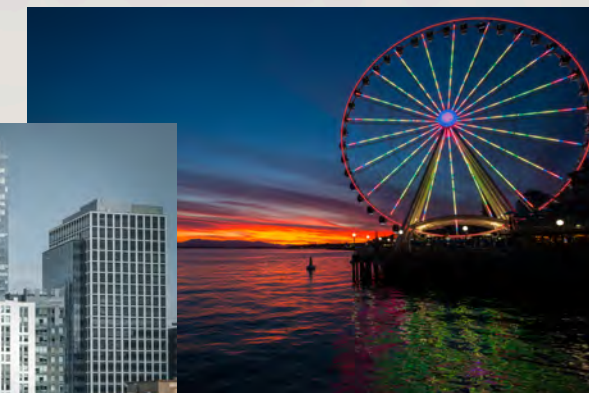
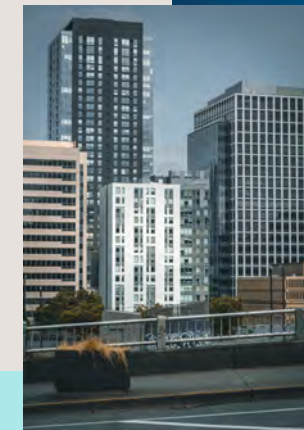

The average home value, according to Zillow, was \$863,432, though it saw a slight dip of 1.4% over the past year.

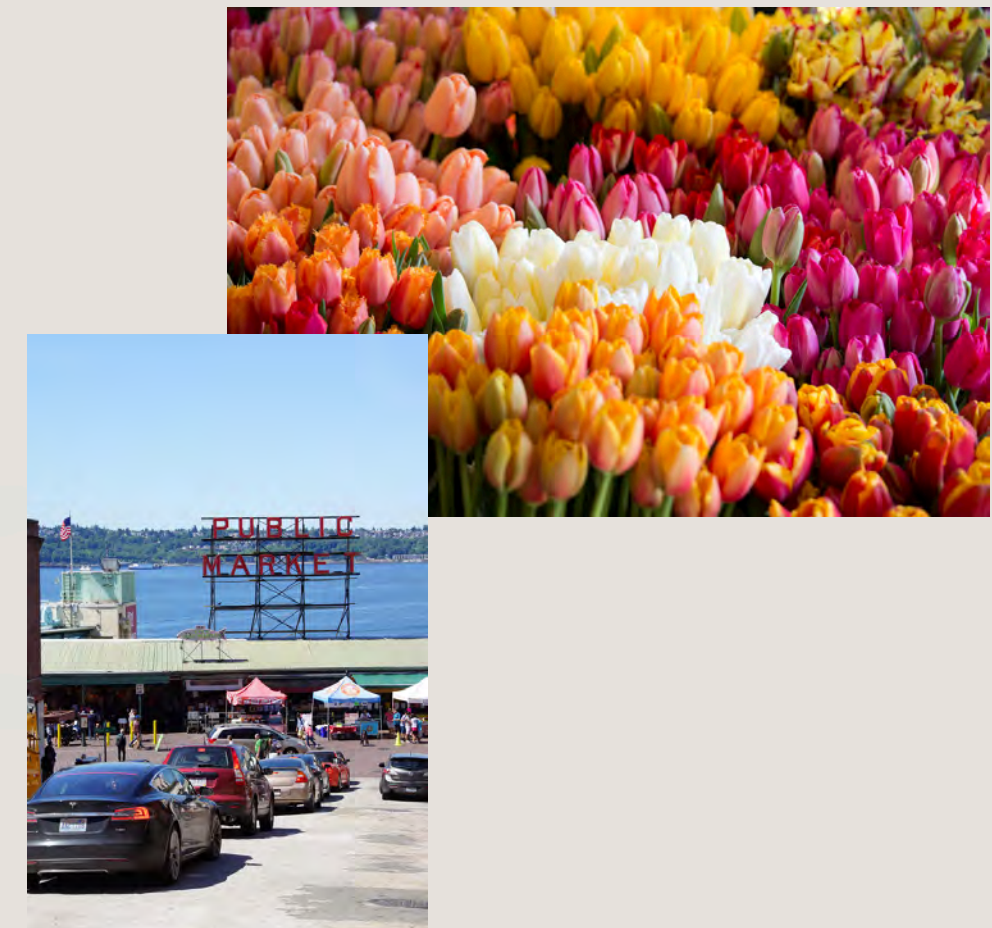
