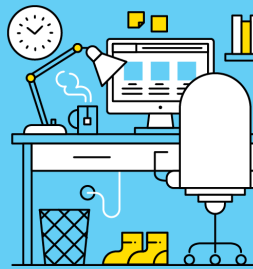


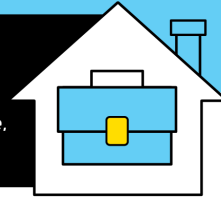

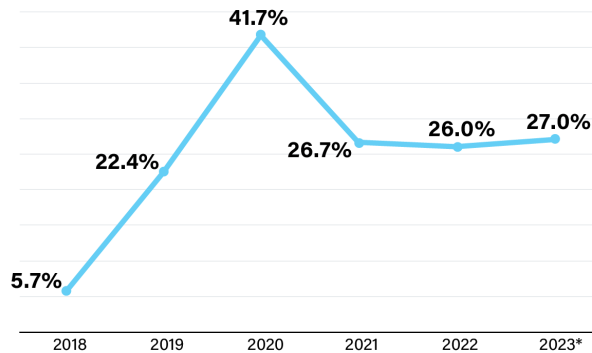
While remote work peaked during the pandemic, many people still work from home today. If you're one of them, it could have an unexpected benefit when you're looking to buy a home.

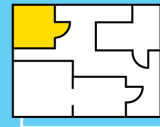


Experience New Places
