

Dog Relocation Checklist - Moving to Maui (2025)

- Microchip implanted and verified as scannable
- First rabies vaccination (must be at least 30 days old)
- Second rabies vaccination (at least 30 days after first)
- FAVN blood test submitted to approved lab (-0.5 IU/mL)
- Wait at least 30 days from blood draw before travel
- Health certificate from veterinarian (issued within 14 days of arrival)
- Complete and submit AQS-279 Dog Import Form
- Submit copies of rabies certs, FAVN results, and microchip info
- Pay Maui Humane Society for Direct Airport Release (\$185 per animal)
- Book flight into Kahului Airport (OGG) during DAR operating hours
- Confirm DAR schedule with Maui Humane Society before departure
- Prepare crate, in-cabin carrier, or airline-compliant travel setup

Tip: Submit your documents at least 10 days before arrival to avoid delays. One small error can result in quarantine on Oahu.
