TEST & CLEAN YOUR SUMP PUMP Slowly pour a few gallons of water into the pit to make sure the pump turns on. Clean debris from bottom with a wet vac. REYERSE CEILING FAN BLADES	CHECK AND SERVICE FIREPLACE AND CHIMNEY Run the tip of a fireplace poker along the interior of the chimney wall. If you find a thick, shiny, tar-like buildup it's
Running the blades in a clockwise position during the colder months can push heated air down. PROTECT YOUR AIR	CHECK AND REPLACE SMOKE ALARM BATTERIES Replace batteries at needed.
CONDITIONER Place a sheet of plywood held down by a few bricks on top and your AC should be ready to work again in the spring	PROTECT OUTDOOR FURNITURE Cover outdoor furniture or consider moving to indoors
Flush HOT WATER TANK Flush your hot water tank to remove sediment	DIVERT WATER Add extensions to downspouts so that water runs at least 3 to 4 feet away from the foundation.
