ABOUT THE MOVING CLOSET

Who is The Moving Closet for?

This volunteer service provides to the most vulnerable members of our local Great Falls community, such as elderly nursing home residents and those transitioning from hospitals with limited resources.

What Does The Moving Closet Offer?

The Moving Closet introduces a novel concept of providing new and gently used clothing that can be accessed by hospital staff and the patient if they are able.

What Sparked the Inspiration?

A family member who is a CNA shared a post highlighting how some individuals only have one or two items of clothing. Reading this was quite disheartening, and it motivated me to find a way to make a positive difference.



Through this simple yet impactful initiative, The Moving Closet seeks to bring a sense of dignity and comfort to individuals facing challenging circumstances, one piece of clothing at a time.

HOW IT WORKS

How does The Moving Closet Work?

The Moving Closet operates by collecting donations of new and gently used clothing from generous individuals or sites in the community. These items are then sorted, organized, and made available on site for hospital staff to distribute to those in need or if they are able ... patients can actually shop.

Why is it referred to as The Moving Closet?

The initial concept involves engaging 1 or 2 participants to periodically transfer the closet inventory between two facilities every two weeks. This rotation aims to maintain the inventory's freshness and accessibility.
