

Bad news: Hawaii is VERY strict when it comes to possessing firearms in Oahu.

Good news: We have 3 easy to follow steps to simplify the process!

Step 1

Book an appointment with HPD to register your weapons sooner rather than later! You have a 72-hour time crunch to have your weapons registered with the Honolulu Police Department. Yes, you heard us correctly, just 3 days from your arrival to Oahu!

This is next part is important, because of health concerns because of the pandemic HPD is only taking appointments. We provided a link to schedule an appointment here:

You can schedule an appointment up to 90-days in advance.

Reminder: Failure to register your firearms could result in a felony charge.

Step 2

Once you have your appointment booked and you are ready to meet with HPD, you need to bring a few items with you. Two forms of identification and proof of ownership of the firearm are required. Of course, you should also bring your unloaded firearms as well as \$16.50 for the fee to be fingerprinted and photographed.

Step 3

This step is only necessary if you are going to live in base housing. Be sure to register your firearms with base security. The only items you will need to bring with you when you meet with base security are; military ID card, HPD verification of registration and proof of base housing residency.
