Talk to Your Kids Early and Often

- Show photos of the new home and Port Royal Park
- Visit Spring Hill before moving day if possible
- Talk about parks, sports, and activities
- Create a goodbye plan for friends.

Packing Order

1. Seasonal decorations and rarely used items
2. Guest room items and books
3. Extra linens and formal dishes
4. Off-season clothing
5. Garage and storage items
6. Everyday essentials last

Tip: Label every box with the room and specific contents. Use color-coded stickers.

First-Night Essentials Kit

Everything you need for a comfortable first night — no digging through boxes required.

- ✓ Medications
- ✓ Toiletries
- ✓ Change of clothes
- ✓ Pajamas
- ✓ Phone chargers
- ✓ Important documents
- ✓ Snacks & bottled water
- ✓ Basic cleaning supplies
- ✓ Paper towels & toilet paper
- ✓ Pet food & supplies
- ✓ Kids' comfort items
- ✓ Basic tools & trash bags

Babies & toddlers: diapers, wipes, formula, bottles + extra clothes.
School-age kids: backpacks, devices & books if school starts soon.

*Pro tip: Keep this kit in your personal vehicle
— never on the moving truck*

Handle Schools, Records & Utilities

School assignment in Spring Hill depends on the exact address. Parts of the city are zoned for Williamson County Schools, while others are zoned for Maury County Schools. Always verify zoning before choosing a home.

Request school records 4–8 weeks before moving, including transcripts, immunization records, and special-education documents.

TIP: Use Team Romines to prioritize homes in preferred school zones.

Schedule shutoffs at your current home and start dates at the new one as soon as your move-in date is firm.

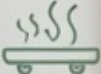

- 2  Bathrooms
- 3  Kitchen
- 4  Kids' rooms
- 5  Pet areas
- 6  Laundry
- 7  Work/school zones

Adjustment Tip:

Some family members settle quickly; others need more time. Restart favorite routines (meals, movie nights, bedtimes) to create continuity. Listen if a child misses the old home.
