use of water for irrigation of 15.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use
of water appurtenant to 3.0 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer
entered February 18, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining
right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate hereto-
fore issued to Nelson Pursel.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.

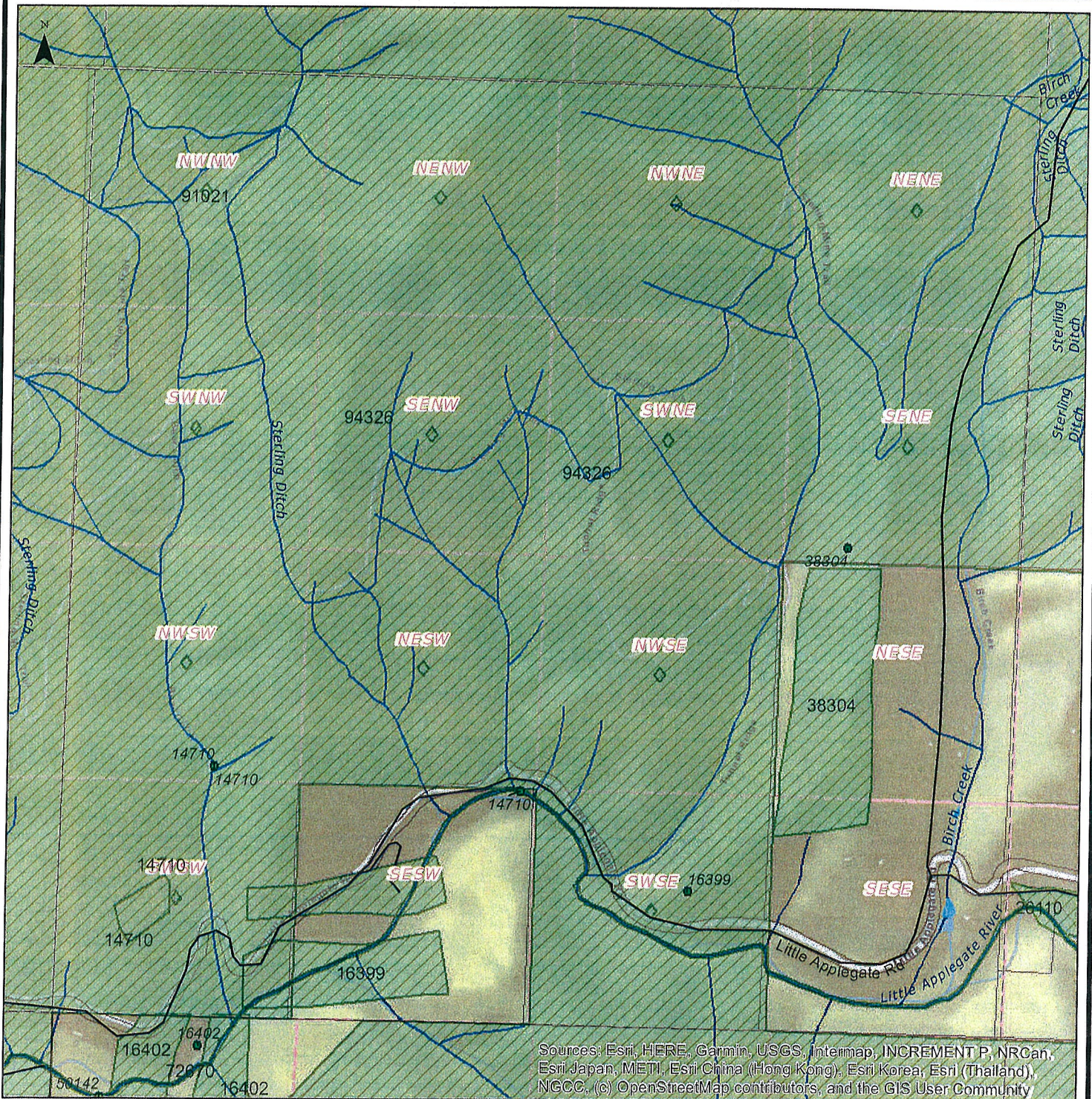

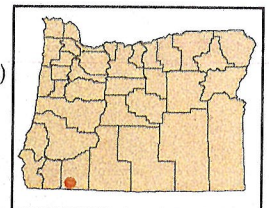

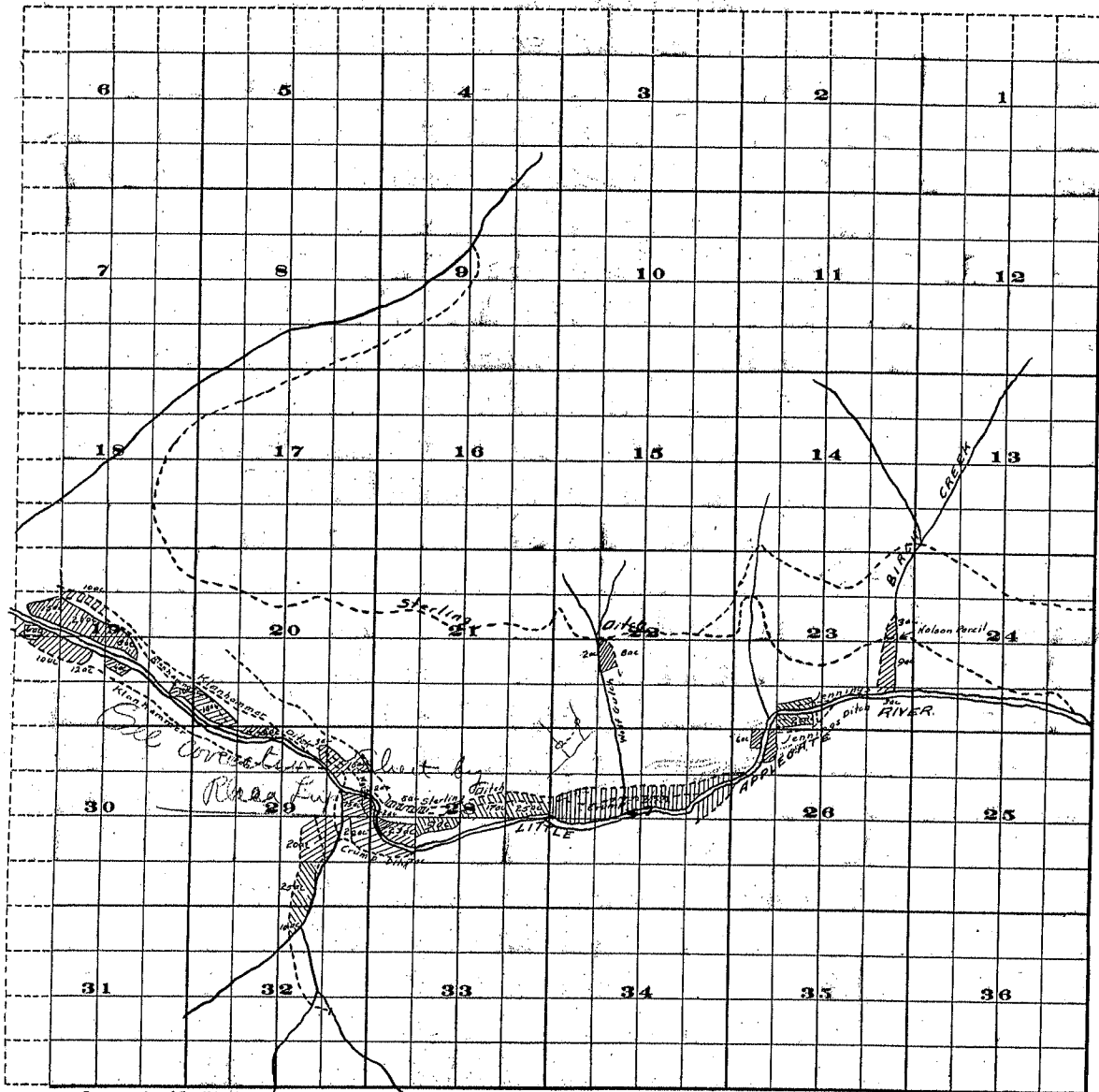
