Hilton Head Island is a foot-shaped barrier island located off the Atlantic Coast of South Carolina, approximately 45 minutes from Savannah, GA, 30 minutes from Beaufort, SC and a quick two-hour drive to Charleston, SC. With convenient access to international airports, shopping, schools, and businesses, everything you need is at an arms-length!

Several direct flights are offered to Hilton Head, including from: Akron/Canton, Atlanta, Baltimore, Boston, Charlotte, Chicago, Cincinnati, Columbus, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Detroit, Houston, Lexington, NYC, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and Washington DC.

A GLANCE INTO OUR HISTORY

Hilton Head is a beautiful island, with a rich history. The town's strong historic roots serve as the foundation for a unique, vibrant, modern-day island culture.

Hilton Head Island was first occupied by Indians.

1450 B.C.

1663

Captain William Hilton, an English Sea Captain, discovered the island when traveling from Barbados. He claimed the land for the British Crown and named it Hilton's Head.

1698

John Bayley of Ireland seized 16,200 acres of land on the island and granted Colonel Alexander Trench as the first real estate agent.

The island was renamed Trench's Island.

1722

1740

Residents started to produce blue dye from Indigo that was introduced to the island. They sold the dye to England, where it was used to dye fabrics. Another natural resource that was a driving force in the early economy of the land was Sea Island Cotton. It grew well here due to the island's warm, subtropical climate.

The island's official name was changed to Hilton Head Island.

1872

1861

The Battle of Port Royal Sound on November 1, 1861, resulted in about 30,000 troops stationing on the island. Soon after, many changes occurred. For example, the name of the island and its post office was changed to "Port Royal," which was the Union's Department of the South.

1986

Modern-day Hilton Head Island was born. Or, rather, developed by Charles Fraser. Development started on the south end of the island first, which Fraser named Sea Pines Plantation. At that time, he established land preservation rules which were not known anywhere else. These rules are adhered to today, in order to preserve the natural environment of our island, including our beautiful beaches, ancient oak trees and palmettos.
