



Fall Home Maintenance Checklist

- Check and clean gutters and downspouts, repair or replace if needed. Full gutters are mosquito breeding areas.
- Remove hoses from outdoor spigots drain the hoses and store. Consider turning off the water supply to outside spigots.
- Check the caulk on windows and doors also weather stripping for repair or replacement.
- Check all exterior lighting, clean and replace bulbs or fixtures if needed.
- Service your furnace, clean and inspect a fireplace, have carpets cleaned, and clean the oven.
- Check your basement, crawl space and foundation for needed repairs and water leaks. Don't wait on these they add up to big dollars if left.
- Check your fire extinguisher and alarm system.
- Organize your garage to get ready for cold weather. Add storage if needed.
- Replace batteries in your smoke detector, replace the whole unit if 5 years old. Write the year purchased if you replace.
- Prepare your lawn mower for storing and other tools/equipment.

Now is also the time to have your auto prepared for Winter by getting it serviced, checking the antifreeze, tire pressure and wear, and windshield wipers. Also, as you get closer to freezing weather add the snow-ice scraper, and winter survival kit for each auto.
